3rd Annual Matthew Renk Memorial Golf Scholarship Awarded To Central Bucks East High School Student

Buckingham, PA, November 9, 2012 –Matthew Kutz of Doylestown, a senior at Central Bucks East High School and member of the school's golf team, is the recipient of the 3rd Annual Matthew Renk Memorial Golf Scholarship awarded by the Matthew Renk Foundation, in Buckingham, PA. Kutz plans to use the scholarship for college as he enters Penn State in the fall of 2013.

Students considered for the scholarship are evaluated on criteria Matt best exemplified: integrity, good sportsmanship, personal character, respect for the game and respect for the course. Successful scholarship applicants must objectively demonstrate a track record of sportsmanship, a passion for the game of golf and an acute understanding of golf etiquette, and an appreciation of the time and effort required to properly maintain and manage any golf course. "Matthew Kutz exemplifies all the criteria for the scholarship", stated Jackie Renk, foundation president, "we were very impressed with his character and were happy to present him with this award."

This is the third year the \$1,000 Matthew Renk Memorial Golf Scholarship has been awarded. The scholarship was created in 2010 in memory of Matthew Renk, son of Jackie and David Renk, the superintendent of Lookaway Golf Club. During a life cut far too short by a cancerous brain tumor, Matt made a tremendous impression on everyone he came into contact with. Matt, who passed away at the age of 15, was a young man of exceptional character. His twin brother Tommy, now a senior at Central Bucks East, delivered a heart-warming speech in the name of his brother at the recent awards banquet, held at Lookaway Golf Club, home of the High School golf team. .
